Three Monthly Forecast

May - July 2009

Issued on 29 April 2009

General Condition

May is the transition period from summer to rainy season and there will be the low pressure

trough that lie across central part and lower portion of northeastern part. In the first half of June,

it will shift northwards to lie across northern and northeastern parts of Thailand before moving to

southern China during the first half of July. Its northward movemment to China will cause rainfall

decrease in Thailand from the end of June to the first half of July. It will return to lie across

northern and northeastern parts of Thailand again in the second half of July. It associated with the

southwest monsoon that will prevail over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand and often strengthen

will result in scattered rain with isolated heavy rainfalls.

Warning:

May - The low pressure cell in the Andaman Sea that sometimes strengthen to be tropical cyclone

may have some effects on Thailand's rainfall especially in northern, central and southern

Thailand.

June and July – The tropical cyclone may generate in the western north Pacific and move to the

South China Sea. This may induce the strength of southwest monsoon and cause increasing in

rainfall especially in eastern and southern Thailand.
