

Three Monthly Forecast

June – August 2009

Issued on 29 May 2009

General Condition

The low pressure trough will lie across northern and northeastern parts of Thailand in the first half of June. Then it will shift northward to lie across southern China. Till in second half of July to August, the low pressure trough will return to lie across northern, northeastern and central parts of Thailand.

Accompanying the southwest monsoon will prevail over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand most of period, with weaken in some period mainly in second half of June to first half of July. Resulting in widely scattered to scattered rain with isolated heavy rainfalls in some period and the dry spell will occur over Thailand.

Warning:

June and July – For this period, the amount of rainfall is not enough to consume including agriculture, the drought condition will occur in some areas mainly upper Thailand.

- The tropical cyclone may generate in the Western North Pacific Ocean or South China Sea, this may induce the strength of southwest monsoon and cause increasing in rainfall especially in eastern and southern Thailand.

August - The tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean may occur and there are high probability that some tropical cyclones will move near and / or pass northeastern or northern Thailand, the people should follow the weather news.
