



Three Monthly Forecast
September – November 2009
Issued August 2009

Meteorological Department

General Condition

The low pressure trough will lie across central, lower portion of northeastern and eastern regions of Thailand in September. Abundant rainfall and floods are expected in some areas. During October to November period, slight rain will remain in upper Thailand as low pressure trough move southward to lie across southern Thailand and high pressure areas from China will occasionally extend its ridge to cover upper Thailand. Cool weather will be in north and northeast regions with cold in the mountainous areas especially in November. Northeast monsoon will prevail, bringing further heavy rain to southern Thailand. However, rainfall amounts are likely below average in several areas.

Warning: There is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean or the South China Sea move near or pass through upper Thailand in September – October and pass through southern Thailand in November. Therefore, people should continually follow the weather news.
