Three Monthly Forecast July – September 2011 Issued on 27 June 2011

General Condition

In the first half of July, the low pressure trough will lie across southern China and southwest monsoon which prevailed over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand will weaken. Rainfall amount will decreasing over Thailand. In August to September, the low pressure trough will move back to lie across the upper Thailand, accompanying, the southwest monsoon prominently prevail over Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand, resulting in increasing in rainfall.

Generally speaking, the amount of rainfall in Thailand will be slightly Above normal, and the average temperature will be slightly above normal.

Warning :

July – The tropical cyclone generating in the Western North Pacific Ocean or South China Sea may induce the strength of southwest monsoon and cause increasing in rainfall especially in eastern and southern Thailand (west coast).

August and September - There is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean move near or pass through the upper Thailand. Therefore, people should continually follow the weather news.
