

Weather outlook for winter season of Thailand (Mid-October 2011 to Mid-February 2012)

## **General Situation**

**Upper Thailand** The winter season will start around mid-October. The northeast monsoon, which occasionally strengthen, will extend to cover upper Thailand and the Gulf of Thailand, resulting in decreasing temperature to become cool to cold weather with morning fog in northern and northeastern parts before the other parts. For central and eastern parts, the temperature will decrease to become cool weather around November. During the some periods in December 2011 and January 2012, very cold in various areas are expected over the upper northern, upper northeastern and the mountainous areas. The northeast monsoon prevailing over Thailand will weaken around mid-February 2011, causing warm air in central, eastern and southern Thailand, however cool weather will persist in northern and northeastern Thailand until early March. This winter season will be terminated around mid-February 2011.

<u>Southern part</u> The northeast monsoon from the Gulf of Thailand through east coast of southern part and accompanying the low pressure trough downward from upper to lower southern part during mid-October to December. So, the fertile rainfalls are expected mostly over the east coast. By the way, during the winter season, the tropical cyclones may develop and move through southern Thailand causing widespread thundershower with heavy to very heavy rainfalls, flood conditions, strong wind, rough sea with wave height 2-4 meters and storm surge in the tropical cyclone areas. The rainfall will decrease and then cool weather will cover around January.

## **Forecast for each parts**

Northern and Northeastern parts. Around mid-October to November, the weather will be Cool to cold with morning fog. For December 2011 to January2012, cold to very cold with dense fog in some areas of Mae Hong Son, Chiang Rai, Phayao, Nan, Tak, Loei, Nong Khai, Bungkan, Sakon Nakhon and Nakhon Phanom, especially in the mountainous areas. Around mid-March the temperature will increase.

**Central and Eastern parts.** Around mid-October to November, Wildly Scattered showers and cool weather with morning fog in some days. Cool weather in general with cold weather in some areas during December to January, especially the mountain areas of Nakhon Sawan, Uthai Thani, Chainat, Kanchanaburi, Ratch Buri, Suphan Buri, Lop Buri, Sara Buri, Nakhon Nayok, Chachoengsao, Prachin Buri, Sakaeo and Chantha Buri. Around February, the weather will be warm to become hot during daytime.

**Southern Thailand (East coast).** Around mid-October to December, the fertile rainfall will persist and isolated heavy to very heavy falls mostly from Chumphon southward, flooding conditions may occur in southern Thailand and the wave height in the Gulf of Thailand will strengthen. Then, the amount and distribution of rainfall will decrease. Cool will be reported in the morning mostly in the upper portion.

**Southern Thailand (West coast).** The fertile rainfall still persist and the wave height in the Andaman Sea will be rather active from mid-October to November. Then, the amount of rainfall will decrease. Cool and morning fog mostly in mid-December.

Bangkok Metropolis and Vicinity. Around mid-October to November, Wildly Scattered showers and cool weather with morning fog in some days. Then, cool weather in general and cold weather in some days with morning light fog. Around February, the weather will be warm to become hot during daytime. <u>Conclusion</u> This winter will begin around mid-October. Mainly temperature will be near normal and average minimum temperature will be below last year (2010-2011). By the way, very cold weather are expected in the upper northern, upper northeastern and the mountainous areas mostly during December 2010 to January 2011. This winter season will be terminated upper Thailand around mid-February 2011. For Southern Thailand, the fertile rainfalls are expected in November and December. Rainfall will be decreasing in January which terminate of rainy season of southern Thailand.
