

Three Monthly Forecast November 2011 – January 2012 Issued on 1 November 2011

General Condition

<u>Upper Thailand</u>. High pressure areas from China will occasionally extend its ridge to cover upper Thailand. Abundant slightly rainfall **remain** in upper Thailand with cool and cold weather especially in December and January. Cold to very cold with dense fog and frost are expected over mountainous areas and mountain tops especially in northern and northeastern Thailand. The amount of rainfall will be slightly above **normal** and the average temperature will be near normal.

<u>Southern part.</u> Low pressure trough will lie across southern Thailand and northeast monsoon will prevail over the Gulf of Thailand and southern part, bringing further heavy rainfall. The amount of rainfall will be slightly above normal and the average temperature will be near normal.

+ + <u>Warning</u> + +

- <u>In November</u>, there is high probability that the tropical cyclones in the Western North Pacific Ocean or the South China Sea move through eastern and southern parts of Thailand. Therefore, people should beware of natural disaster and follow the weather news.
- In December and January, Westerly trough may move from Mynmar through upper Thailand, causing thundershowers and gust in some areas. The active low pressure cell in the lower Gulf of Thailand may be move through southern Thailand, causing abundant rainfall in those areas, people and navigators should follow the weather forecast for further information.
